



Software Updating Procedures

CCM

Barracuda

Eagle Eye

Updated April 2011

Checking Version

To check which version your products are on:

CCM: The version of your CCM will be displayed in the welcome window as you start the program. It will also be displayed in the lower right hand corner of the home screen as the letter 'v' followed by 2.##.

As of April 2011, the most current version of the CCM is v 2.32.

Barracuda/Eagle Eye: Power on the unit and select Setup. Scroll down to the serial number of the unit and press select. The version number will be displayed on the bottom of this screen.

As of April 2011, the most current version of the Barracuda and Eagle Eye is 3.18V.

Updating the CCM

It is highly recommended that you update your CCM software before using for the first time. The CCM program must be installed and you must be logged in to update. Your computer must also be connected to the internet. A broadband connection is recommended.

To Update:

1. Ensure that your CCM module is connected to your computer and open the CCM program.
2. Click on the Update CCM icon under the Utilities section on the home screen. You can also select Update CCM Software from the Systems menu.
3. The CCM will search for the latest update found online and download and install it automatically. This process might take up to 5 minutes.
4. Once your CCM installs the new software (automatically) it will restart itself. You will notice the CCM close and restart. The new version number will display upon start up.
5. If your CCM home screen is grayed out, you may need to log back in. Select Field Setup from the File menu and enter your information. You can verify your CCM version on the home screen of the CCM. It will be displayed in the lower right hand corner as v 2.##.

You can visit www.PredatorGames.info to check what the latest version of software is. The complete setup file is available for download from the site as well, in case you need to reinstall the software and no longer have the disc.

Updating the Barracuda or Eagle Eye

To update the Barracuda or Eagle Eye, the most current version of CCM software must be installed on the computer. The only way to update the Barracuda and Eagle Eye is through the CCM software. Be sure your units all have fresh batteries.

For the purposes of these instructions, the word 'gun' will be used and is used in place of both Barracuda and Eagle Eye.

To Update:

1. Open up your CCM select Sign Up Players, preferably under Basic Play.
2. If you do not already have players for each of your guns, create them by selecting Sign Up Player. For now, just use numbers for the First and Code name's of each. So the first player would have a first name and code name of 1. The second gun would be 2, and so on.
3. Sync all of your guns to the players we just created. Double click on each player and select Sync Equipment. On the gun, select Sync then Sync to Server.
4. Click Update Systems from the Systems menu. You will be brought to the updating screen and all the guns that you have synced will be listed.
5. Select a gun and then click Upload System. You will be prompted to type 'YES' to process. Type that in and press enter. The update will begin. On the gun, you will see a percentage counting up. It takes up to 5 minutes per gun.

IT IS IMPORTANT TO NOTE THAT YOU CAN ONLY UPDATE ONE GUN AT A TIME. PLEASE COMPLETE UPDATING EACH GUN BEFORE YOU PROCEED TO THE NEXT ONE.

6. When the gun has reached 100% it will verify the update and power down. The CCM screen will state that the update is complete. Click OK. Power the recently updated gun back on and let it sit. It will flash sporadically and appear to be off. DO NOT TOUCH THE GUN AT THIS TIME. It is silently updating itself and will power back on automatically.
7. Verify the version number of unit by selecting Setup and then the serial number. The version number is displayed at the bottom of this screen.
8. You can than begin updating the next gun. Repeat steps 5-7.

It is advised that you delete every player after updating all the guns. You will want to create new players with names of your choice and resync each of the guns to these new players.
